Announcement of the Defence Technology Institute

Subject: Policy of Not Accepting All Kinds of Gifts and Gratuities from Performing Duties (No Gift Policy)
Fiscal Year 2026

The Defence Technology Institute (DTI) is committed to strengthening a culture of integrity, transparency, and adherence to moral and ethical principles. To prevent conflicts of interest and corruption in the performance of duties, DTI hereby declares its intention to be an agency where all government officials do not accept gifts or gratuities of any kind from performing their duties (No Gift Policy). The following guidelines are established for all executives, officers, and employees

1. Executives, officers, and employees of the Defence Technology Institute, including their family members, shall not accept gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits of any kind before, during, or after the performance of their duties. This includes any benefits that may have value, influence decision-making, lead to conflicts of interest, or result in corruption and misconduct. (Exceptions are made only for acceptance in accordance with ethical standards and criteria prescribed by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC), and such actions must strictly comply with relevant laws, rules, and regulations.)

2. Executives, officers, and employees of the Defence Technology Institute shall refrain from giving gifts, gratuities, or any other benefits to external parties in the course of performing their duties.

3. Executives, officers, and employees must not seek, request, or accept any benefits that could be perceived as gifts, gratuities, or unlawful interests.

4. To express congratulations, well-wishes, hospitality, or condolences on various traditional occasions, actions shall be taken by signing greeting cards, blessing books, or condolence cards, or by using electronic media and social media channels instead of giving physical objects.

5. All executives, officers, and employees of the Defence Technology Institute have the duty to inform external parties of this policy to ensure strict and consistent compliance.

This announcement shall be strictly observed by all.
